

**HIAWATHA FIREFIGHTER'S ASSOCIATION  
STANDING MOTIONS**

Record of Standing Motions (Revised 12 June 2001)

1. [18 Jul 82] Destroy all ballots when a decision is reached.
2. [9 Nov 82, amended 12 Jun 01] The Association sends the following:

Flowers to:

- 2.1. Firefighters in the hospital.
- 2.2. Death of a city employee
- 2.3. Death of a current or former Hiawatha firefighter or the immediate family of a current Hiawatha firefighter. The immediate family includes spouse, children, parents and grandparents, if they raised the member in place of the parents.

Cards to:

- 2.4. Death in a firefighter' s close family.
- 2.5. Other departments or organizations at the discretion of the Association officers or the fire chief.
- 2.6. Firefighter' s marriage, birth in firefighter' s immediate family or special occasion.

(Special instructions to secretary on flowers. Coordinate with Chief. If secretary handles order: call Peck' s, let them select flowers for the occasion and bill against the Firefighter' s Association.)

3. [14 Mar 84] Treasurer may purchase stamps and envelopes as needed.
4. [11 Mar 86] Any donation of \$50.00 or more to the Association receives a thank you note from the secretary.
5. [10 Apr 90] The Association purchases Serving Since tags and HFD collar tags for a firefighter finishing probation.
6. [10 Aug 93] If the Fire Auxiliary ever reconvenes, the Association shall give it \$100.00 for startup.
7. [11 Jul 95] The Association will keep the fire department' s vehicles supplied with bottled water and Gatorade.
8. [14 Apr 98] All soda machine reimbursements shall be automatically approved and reimbursed upon submission to the treasurer.
9. [12 May 98] The Association will send \$100.00 to the memorial fund established for every firefighter line of duty death in the state of Iowa.
10. [12 Jun 01] The value of flowers in the 9 Nov 82 standing motion is set at \$50.00 when money is sent in lieu of flowers.
