## Restoring Equipment

When the apparatus return to the station, all members will help in replacing hose, servicing SCBA, cleaning equipment, restocking EMS bags, and any other duties that need to be accomplished to place the apparatus back in service. Placing apparatus back in service is a high priority in order to have the equipment ready for the next alarm.

The following is a list of priorities in which the equipment shall be restored:

### First Priority

1. Fill the apparatus with water
2. Reload and replace all hose
3. Fill the apparatus with fuel
4. Place all SCBA's back in service
5. Fill all spare SCBA cylinders

### Second Priority

1. Wash hose
2. Clean the apparatus
3. Clean additional equipment
4. Roll hose

### Last Priority

1. Coffee, Pop, Food
2. Relaxation
3. Fellowship

**NOTE:** It is important to rehab after many incidents before equipment can be restored. Rest if needed and drink plenty of fluids.

### Firefighter Responsibilities:

1. Hoses and SCBA including cylinders

### Driver Responsibilities:

1. Water and Fuel

### Officer Responsibilities

1. Reports and assuring all equipment is restored.
