Mutual Aid

Hiawatha Fire and Rescue shall respond to all requests for mutual aid as staffing and apparatus are available.

Requests for:

Engine – 285 shall respond staffed as per the Apparatus Manning Procedure.

Tanker – 280 shall respond staffed as per the Apparatus Manning Procedure.

Manpower – 281 shall respond with up to six persons.

Aerial – Truck 1 shall respond as per the Apparatus Manning Procedure.

Rehabilitation, Light and Air (SCBA) fill – 281 shall respond with one officer or senior firefighter, one or two firefighters.

Grass Truck – 289 shall respond staffed as per the Apparatus Manning Procedure.

EMS – when Medical Mutual Aid is requested, only Certified EMS personnel should staff 289 as per the Apparatus Manning Procedure.

All other requests – the senior officer / firefighter initially arriving at the station shall contact the agency requesting mutual aid to find out what the exact needs of that agency are.
